Dear Valued ERRCO Customer:

ERRCO has always attempted to set a high standard in its operations while providing you with competitive pricing for your construction and demolition debris disposal. Our high standards have included a strong emphasis on health and safety. One of the issues that we are particularly diligent in is trying to keep any materials that contain asbestos from our processing line. The following is a general statement that is the foundation for ERRCO's asbestos monitoring, screening and abatement program:

Policy Statement

ERRCO will not knowingly accept any loads of construction and demolition materials that contain friable or Category 1 and 2 non-friable asbestos materials since our permit excludes the acceptance of such materials and good health and safety practice requires that we keep such materials from reaching our processing system. All loads will be screened and inspected to verify that they do not contain friable or non-friable asbestos. No loads will be received at ERRCO after operating hours or after dark, whichever is earlier.

Through this policy, ERRCO will allow its customers to immediately remove loads that have been determined to be contaminated with Category 1 and/or 2 non-friable asbestos containing materials. (By law, any loads that contain friable asbestos must still be isolated in place and remediated by a qualified abatement contractor.) At your choice, loads that contain non-friable asbestos containing materials may be immediately reloaded onto the truck delivering the load to the ERRCO facility for transport to any other location of your choosing.

Ownership of any material received for processing at the ERRCO facility will not transfer to ERRCO until the load has been inspected and determined to be acceptable. Ownership of any loads determined to be unacceptable will remain with the customer at all times throughout the unloading, inspection and reloading process.

It is the customer's responsibility to assure that all contaminated loads removed from the ERRCO facility site are managed in a manner that conforms to all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations.

The customer will be immediately notified of any loads that are rejected for contamination with Category 1 and/or 2 asbestos containing materials. A Contaminated Load Removal Log will be immediately completed for all loads that the customer removes from the ERRCO site. A copy of this log will be given to the truck driver and faxed to you.
